Reflection

In high school I was part of a choir and a "Singing Christmas Tree." The concert season was rigorous, a good portion of the month of December, and included travel and assembling and taking down the stacked riser Christmas

Tree. This was no easy task: the tree had eight levels and needed to accommodate the weight and distribution of 60+ bodies. The wood platforms were supported by steel piping which was attached with safety in mind.

The two young men who held this responsibility were dedicated to meeting the needs of the schedule and safety. They both also sang in the choir, one a tenor and the other a bass. One of the fellows spent his free time reading scripture and the other, goofing around with a playful sensibility. Each was unique but bonded by purpose. Oh, and both gentlemen came into this world with cerebral palsy.

Neither of the young men ever complained of the intense schedule or labor required to assemble and dismantle the risers, they just accomplished what needed to be done and always with a smile and generous spirit. Some of us were aware there was a physical toll from all the activity and excessive stressing of the muscles due to their cerebral palsy. We knew that both required massage and stretching to mollify the muscle spasms and increased rigidity resulting from their toil. Regardless, they carried on, both gentle and humble souls, with courageous hearts, exceptional examples of the virtue of fortitude.
