### **Today's Gospel**

### Reflection

Growing up, my Mom was a weather-bug, constantly listening to weather

forecasts and later, keeping the TV on the Weather Channel. This was an ongoing experience of amusement among us siblings when we visited Mom as adults. I have to say, Mom rubbed off on me as I, too, am a weather-bug (if you could see my iPad now and the number of weather apps on it – you would be amused)!

It is very easy for me to picture storms that wash away homes and businesses as I've watched my fair share of Top Ten weather disasters – once again on the Weather Channel. When I juxtapose my house of faith with these storms, I shudder, because just as the waves erode sandy beaches, so too can my own complacency erode what undergirds my faith.

Advent allows time to reflect and assess my "house of faith." Has the soil (my commitment to prayer) started to erode? Has sand (sin) seeped in and found a home? When the rains come (life's curves and pitfalls), can I withstand these challenges? Advent gives us this time to quiet ourselves, connect more deeply with the Beloved, and nurture our relationships with one another.

At one point in my own life, depression set in. At this time, I found my house was built on rock because despite not sensing God's presence, deep within the marrow of my being, I knew God was present. By being diligent and committed to tending to my relationship with God, I trusted in his presence even in my inner darkness. Advent is a wonderful time to re-commit to our relationships with God and others. And remember to be watchful! Be present! Prepare your house ... for we dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of our lives.
