Excerpts from Today's First Reading and Gospel

Stephen, filled with grace and power, was working great wonders and signs among the people. Certain members of the so-called Synagogue of Freedmen, Cyreneans, and Alexandrians, and people from Cilicia and Asia, came forward and debated with Stephen, but they could not withstand the wisdom and the Spirit with which he spoke.

Reflection

The first reading from Acts is filled with the energy of faith, hope, joy, love, and

promise. St. Stephen is described as being filled with grace and power. Those opposing him could not withstand the wisdom and spirit with which he spoke. While I am no prophet or Saint, what I resonate with in this passage from Acts is the sense of being guided by the Holy Spirit. Whenever I am asked to write a reflection or speak to a large audience, my prayer is always to the Holy Spirit. I ask for guidance and wisdom that whatever I write or speak may flow from God's grace. Don't we all desire to be instruments and vessels of God's wisdom and Word? It is one way we can respond to our call to be God's love in the world.

In the gospel passage from John, the words that bubbled up within me as soon as I finished reading this scripture were "the steadfast love of the Lord never ceases." I also pondered the end of this passage, "Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you." Once again, we are reminded that living in Jesus is the way we are invited to be his disciples. If we believe that Jesus was sent by God, then we who believe are being sent by God to do the work that we were created to do.



For Pondering


- How does the Holy Spirit work in your life? When have you called upon the Holy Spirit to guide your way?
