ROMANS 11:33

Reflection

During this week I will be using the word AUTUMN as an acronym to reflect on each day's readings. For today, the word is AWE. For the rest of this week, the following words will be used.

AUTUMN

A: Awe

U: Understanding

T: Trust

U: Underneath

M: Mighty N: Nature

Awe. A three-letter word packed with mystery, astonishment, joy, and so many other emotions. When I listen with my heart, my whole being draws quiet to capture the hidden awesomeness of God! When I read the sentence, "Oh, the depths of riches and wisdom and knowledge of God," it flows from the word "awe." Our God is an awesome God, one who continually surprises us with new insights into his presence within and around us.

Reflecting on "the depths of riches" immediately stops me in my tracks. What are the depths of riches in my own life? Each time we read, reflect, and pray with the scriptures, we have the opportunity to be awed. Do we approach scripture this way? Do we prepare our minds and hearts to receive what God will gift us whenever we spend time pondering the mysteries within scripture?
