# **Today's Responsorial Psalm**

### Save me, O Lord, in your kindness.

You will free me from the snare they set for me for you are my refuge.
Into your hands I commend my spirit;
you will redeem me, O Lord, O faithful God.

I hear the whispers of the crowd, that frighten me from every side, as they consult together against me, plotting to take my life.

But my trust is in you, O Lord; I say, "You are my God." In your hands is my destiny; rescue me from the clutches of my enemies and my persecutors.

PSALM 31:5-6, 14, 15-16

#### Reflection

In praying Psalm 31, what surfaced within me were the many stories I've heard about bullying; especially the anonymous messages that are all over the various web-based platforms. I recently read about a young teenager who took her own life because of the bullying she received at school and on social media.

Perhaps Psalm 31 might have brought her comfort in her distress as the response to each stanza is "Save me, O Lord, in your kindness." This is a soothing Psalm; imagine it as a balm for the anxieties and burdens that might be a part of your journey at this moment in time.

This Psalm gifts us with words that gently touch our hearts; words such as kindness, refuge, redeem, faithful, trust, destiny, and "you are my God." During this Lenten journey, allow each word to float within the soul-space where you encounter the Beloved.

## **For Pondering**


