## Reflection

The readings that follow Easter are filled with excitement and inspiration as the early Church churns with the Holy Spirit's stirrings. The scripture passage opening this reflection is written by Paul just before his death and as he closes the epistle, he asks for help, particularly from Mark. "All hands-on deck," a call to get the Good Word out and chronicled.

Mark the Evangelist proclaimed the teachings of Jesus as a preacher and writer of the shortest Gospel. It is thought to be largely built on the preaching of Peter. Some traditions hold that Mark founded the Church of Alexandria and established the Coptic Church.

One of the most significant pilgrimage moments for me was to visit St. Mark's Basilica in Venice, and to recognize his influence in helping to establish early Christianity. It is absolutely remarkable to consider how Christianity spread from the inspired efforts of a small group of hearts on fire. Today is the Feast Day of St. Mark the Evangelist. Happy Feast Day!

- Contemplate and just be with the moment and God. Act as so called.


