Today's Second Reading

Brothers and sisters:

You are God's building.

According to the grace of God given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building upon it. But each one must be careful how he builds upon it, for no one can lay a foundation other than the one that is there, namely, Jesus Christ.

Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person; for the temple of God, which you are, is holy.

1 CORINTHIANS 3:9c-11, 16-17

Reflection

In today's reading from First Corinthians, I was drawn to the reality of our being the dwelling place of God from whom all blessings and life flow.

With St. Paul, I say, "Brothers and sisters ... you are the temple of God, and the Spirit of God dwells in you." Think about it! The marvelous mystery of divine life lives within us. Each person has been graced with the Divine imprint upon our souls which gives us dignity and draws us to a personal relationship with God. What are the ways in which you have realized this union with God that brings life, goodness, love, mercy, compassion and a deep belonging? Amazing that we are gifted with such Presence!

There I would discover sacred encounter with God that would transform my living with purpose and hone the skills of discernment. Putting on the mind and heart of Jesus became my desire and a bonding presence.

I do not know exactly how or when the indwelling presence of God became a tangible reality within me, yet, in God's time, I have come to know God's companioning presence within my being. Though ordinary natural sights, sounds, people, and beauty, I am reminded of God's abiding presence and graciousness.


For Pondering
