Today's First Reading

Indeed, you do this for all the brothers throughout Macedonia. Nevertheless, we urge you, brothers and sisters, to progress even more, and to aspire to live a tranquil life, to mind your own affairs, and to work with your own hands, as we instructed you.


1 THESSALONIANS 4:9-11

Reflection

In this first letter of Paul to the Christians at Thessalonica, Paul realizes that these Gentile believers have already learned the importance of fraternal charity in building up the community which extends into the vast area of Macedonia.

Paul, who founded this church after he left nearby Phillipi, speaks tenderly to them, saying that they have been **taught by God** to love one another; they do not need further instruction by Paul.

Whenever I see this phrase in the Hebrew and Christian scriptures, I find myself resonating with it: I am convinced that God desires to mold us and shape us in God's own intimate ways. Ignatius of Loyola directed the givers of the Spiritual Exercises to "leave the Creator to deal with the creature" making the retreat (Fifteenth Annotation). In Jeremiah 31:34, we read, "There will be no further need for everyone to teach neighbor or brother saying, 'Learn to know Yahweh!' No, they will all know me, the least no less than the greatest." In John 6:45, we read, "It is written in the prophets: 'And they will all be taught by God."




