

# Reflection

What I find helpful in St. Paul's letter to the Romans is his reminder to us all about being a part of the Body of Christ. We are each given the graces and gifts

from God to contribute to the building up of the Body of Christ for the common good.

It once again takes humility on our part not to succumb to the temptation of comparing our gifts to others. This is not helpful because it can become divisive. God has given us the gifts we have because God wants us to use them – generously and for others.

This first reading flows beautifully into the responsorial psalm, where we pray to God, "In you, O Lord, I have found my peace." When we graciously accept and use our gifts, we both receive and give of ourselves with joy and generosity, leaving a deep sense of peace within us.

The parable of the Great Banquet from Luke once again steers us toward reflecting on whether we are open to God's invitations in our lives. Are we, like those who are making excuses for not attending the banquet, finding excuses for why we are rejecting some of God's invitations in our lives?
