# **Today's Responsorial Psalm**

R. (4a) Remember us, O Lord, as you favor your people.


They fashioned a calf at Horeb, bowed low and worshiped it. They traded their God for a grass-chewing idol.

They forgot their God, their savior, the One who gave signs in Egypt, marvels in the land of Pharaoh, and terror at the Red Sea, the One who would destroy them, had not Moses, God's chosen one, stood alone before him, deflecting the divine wrath.

#### Reflection

This community lament psalm reviews Israel's national history, the Exodus-Conquest, with the focus on the rebellious spirit of the Chosen People, i.e., their worship of the golden calf at Sinai: "They traded their God for a grass-chewing idol. They forgot God, their savior, the One who gave signs in Egypt, marvels in the land of Pharaoh." Despite their blatant disregard for God, Moses intercedes for the people, and they are saved once again. Communities of faith even today continue to forget divine acts of saving compassion. This psalm, as well as some people in our lives, remind us that despite human unfaithfulness God's steadfast love endures forever.
