## **An Excerpt from Today's Gospel**

When Herod realized that he had been deceived by the magi, he became furious. He ordered the massacre of all the boys in Bethlehem and its vicinity two years old and under, in accordance with the time he had ascertained from the magi. Then was fulfilled what had been said through Jeremiah the prophet:

A voice was heard in Ramah, sobbing and loud lamentation; Rachel weeping for her children, and she would not be consoled, since they were no more.

**MATTHEW 2:16-18** 

While these days are formally the celebration of the 12 days of Christmas, today's Gospel plunges us deep into the grief and sorrow of innocent life violently taken by the delusional, self-gratifying need to be the only one to wield power. Unconditional love stands in stark contrast to sin and evil. The juxtaposition of good and evil reminds people of faith to cultivate compassion, mercy, love, generosity, and God's life within us.

right relationship?


- What enables you to see and reflect God's loving gaze in people you encounter each day?
