Observing the boldness of Peter and John and perceiving them to be uneducated, ordinary men, the leaders, elders, and scribes were amazed, and they recognized them as the companions of Jesus.

### Reflection

I'm captured by the word "boldness" in describing the discipleship of Peter and John, and how others recognized them as companions of Jesus. This speaks directly to our own discipleship and prompts the question, how might others describe us as followers and companions of Jesus? I must admit that there is an unease as I reflect on my way of discipleship and question how others would describe my way of being as a follower of Jesus. Am I conveying, with my life, the deep faith I profess?

Throughout this Easter week, we've read about the doubting of Peter and the other disciples. At the same time, we've witnessed their response to Jesus' promptings, like yesterday's casting of their nets into the Sea of Tiberias. My own faith journey is much like that of the disciples, filled with courage in some instances, and remaining silent at times when perhaps I ought to speak from a heart of faith. Noting how our journey in life has many twists and turns along the way, we're reminded that we can alter our life's direction. This is empowering and enables each of us to tap into a deeper sense of courage to "go into the whole world and proclaim the Gospel to every creature" (Mk 16:15).


