# **Excerpt from Today's Responsorial Psalm**

God is king over the nations,
God sits on his holy throne.
The princes of the peoples are gathered together
with the people of the God of Abraham.
For God's are the guardians of the earth;
God is supreme.

**PSALM 47:8-10** 

#### Reflection

The Judeo-Christian tradition recognizes heavenly spirits who serve as

messengers of God and protectors of creation. The "princes of the people" and "the guardians of the earth" in this psalm most likely refer to these angelic spirits who watch over the earth and various nations. Over time and experience some spirits were named and acquired specific "ministries." Again, with the presence of angelic beings we see that God's choice of operating as "king" is not dominance over others. Rather, God continues to create and save by partnering with various creatures to nourish and sustain life.

Divine energy is also focused on gathering together. As God's partners, angelic spirits -- along with ourselves -- participate in this gathering movement. We offer our time and energy to "bring all people [creation] to God." It is together that our life takes on meaning.
