Today's First Reading

Reflection

The consoling words in Wisdom 3:1-9 are frequently chosen for the Celebration of Life or funeral of a loved one. These verses describe how the world looks upon death as a calamity, whereas a godly person understands the death of a faithful person in this way: the souls of the virtuous are at peace in the hand of God. Holy Wisdom offers a promise of hope: "the faithful shall abide with God in love." Intimacy with God is a precious gift to a just one, to a merciful one: they will dwell with God in love. To dwell in Love! At the time of our passing, the circle of life is complete – what more could we desire?
