

CALL TO HOLINESS

Today's Second Reading

Beloved: Bear your share of hardship for the gospel with the strength that comes from God.

He saved us and called us to a holy life,
not according to our works
but according to his own design
and the grace bestowed on us in Christ Jesus before time began,
but now made manifest through the appearance
of our savior Christ Jesus,
who destroyed death and brought life and immortality
to light through the gospel.

2 TIMOTHY 1:8b-10

Reflection

As I reflected on today's second reading, I was stuck by the following words: "... He saved us and called us to a holy life, not according to our works but according to his own design."

What is a holy life? I jotted down a few words that came to mind as I read "holy life" — prayer, relationships, intentionality, and presence. As I pondered what God might be speaking to each of us in this second week of Lent, I began by looking more closely at my own life and I urge you to do the same. Here's what surfaced within me:

- Prayer (Life)
- Relationships (God/Self/Others)
- Intentionality (focus)
- Presence (in the present moment).

By reflecting on these four aspects of my life, I was able to see where I'm meeting the Holy One and where I'm missing opportunities for further exploration of God at work in life.

As a Sister of St. Joseph and being steeped in Trinitarian spirituality, I find Lent a time for digging deep and being honest with myself in assessing how I'm relating with God, others, and myself. With the words from the second reading for today, "called us to a holy life," I was able to reflect on the important relationships in my life.

Each of us is called to holiness in the concrete realities of our lives. Pausing to reflect on the relationality of the Trinity, through our prayer life, daily actions and inactions, presence with others and oneself, and being present in the moments of encounter each day, are opportunities to grow in holiness through our connections with one another.

Lent can sometimes feel like an endless, uphill journey; and yet it provides sacred space for us to be accountable to God, others, and ourselves. I urge you to take time during these weeks of Lent and allow the whispers of the Spirit to guide you on your sacred journey.
