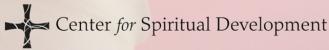

An Excerpt from Today's Gospel

Jesus said to his disciples:

"Do not let your hearts be troubled.

You have faith in God; have faith also in me.

In my Father's house there are many dwelling places.

If there were not,

would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you?

And if I go and prepare a place for you,

I will come back again and take you to myself,

so that where I am you also may be."

JOHN 14:1-3

Reflection

As we journey deeper into life through the truth of the Resurrection, we are

reminded of God's desire to be known deep within our hearts, our lives. Jesus promises to prepare a place for us with him and in God. The temptation is to think that the fulfillment of the promise only comes at the end of our time on earth, when we say "Goodbye, world," and are drawn into God. This is the mystery of having overcome death for life eternal. My faith and experience of Jesus tells me this is true. My seeking to live in God with age, wisdom, and grace these many years has revealed to me that the promise is already being fulfilled within my soul, day by day. "In him we live, move, and have our being." (Acts 17:28)

"The many dwelling places" are also found now in the realization that God dwells in me and you from the beginning of life.
