Reflection

This year, the Saturday of Thanksgiving weekend, is the last Saturday in the Church year, marking today as a “***New Year’s Eve***” of sorts. There is wisdom in reflecting on what we “***see happening indicating God’s Kingdom is near.***” The seamless presence of God is already in our lives. The kingdom of God is within us.

I am drawn to ponder the blessings, challenges, and gifts of this past year. God has promised to be with us always, even to the end of the ages. I pause now to be quiet and still my racing mind and simply be in “soul space.” While I offer prompts to assist your reflection, choose one or two that resonate.

Meister Eckhart, 12th century priest and mystic, said , “***If the only prayer you ever say in your entire life is thank you, it will be enough.***” I give thanks to God for all that has nourished and inspired me this past year. I rejoice in God’s companioning presence and rejoice in the hope that flourishes within me. I pray that I may always recognize and appreciate the beauty of the kingdom within and all around, revealed through *the good things happening, amid struggles and seeming darkness.* ***I “see and know that the Kingdom of God is near.”***
