Today's First Reading

Brothers and sisters: From the day we heard about you, we do not cease praying for you and asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of God's will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, so as to be fully pleasing, in every good work bearing fruit and growing in the knowledge of God, strengthened with every power, in accord with his glorious might, for all endurance and patience, with joy giving thanks to the Father, who has made you fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light. He delivered us from the power of darkness and transferred us to the Kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

COLOSSIANS 1:9-14

This letter was written to the Christian community in Colossae, Asia Minor, a town east of Ephesus. Paul has not yet visited this community, however, he has heard of their faith and love so writes from that vantage point. He prays that they "be filled" with "knowledge" of God's will in "all spiritual wisdom" and "understanding." The meaning of these words is lived out in the lives of the community members, shown by their "every good work bearing fruit." Connection/ relationship with God is not a solitary endeavor. Rather, it always entails bringing life beyond oneself, or the one community, represented in "every good work" that extends to others.

pure and flawless.


Let my every characteristic be
