Jesus said to his disciples:

"I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!"

LUKE 12:49

Reflection

This scripture awakens my own passion for the ways of God's great love to be experienced in the heart of every person. When I was a young sister, I was once introduced as a "passionate woman." I was startled by the introduction, even embarrassed. Yet, upon reflection, I had to admit that passion rumbles around within me.

Passion for God ignites a desire in me for all people to experience God's great

love for them personally. Jesus spoke of this desire when he wished that the "fire" of his mission be ignited. His desire for God and God's ways fueled all he did in life in relationship with the Father. Jesus is the presence of God among us. God's great love can transform human hearts and the world.

This Gospel cited above is powerful, and seems so contrary to the desire of God "that all be one" (John 17:21). Yet, for me, the yearning for "fire on the earth" is very much ablaze today in our church, society, and world reality. Too many leaders and their followers today are promoting a way of life that is exclusive, self-centered on power and wealth at the exclusion of the majority of people.

The Word of God, on the other hand, urges toward the dignity of every person, caring for the poor and vulnerable, and unrelenting reverence for the dignity of all people and creation as made in God's likeness. God is all-inclusive, all-permeating, self-emptying Love for us all. We are loved into life and urged to love as God loves.


Often the powers that are in control of governments and so many other areas of society are far from the kingdom of God as greed, power, exclusion, oppression are the order of the day. What has happened to love, mercy, compassion, care for the dear neighbor, inclusion, and right relationship?


