Go out to all the world and tell the Good News.

Praise the Lord, all you nations, glorify him, all you peoples!

For steadfast is his kindness toward us, and the fidelity of the Lord endures forever.

PSALM 117:1BC, 2

Reflection

During this week of reflections, I will be using the acronym HARVEST. Each day the focus will be on the letter for that day as noted below. I'm using the theme of fall and autumn and how this season can be used as a kaleidoscope to reflect on our life with God. As this is Wednesday, the word of focus is **Vibrant**.

Sunday ~ H: Harmony Monday ~ A: Awesome Tuesday ~ R: Rejoice

Wednesday ~ V: Vibrant

Thursday ~ E: Everlasting

Friday ~ S: Steadfast.

Saturday ~ T: Testimony

If you pray the stanzas from Psalm 117, you can see and experience the vibrancy of these words. In the first stanza, we are asked to praise the Lord and glorify God. We can respond in so many ways and our very lives can be our response. When we praise God in prayer and song, our voices ring out and joy and gratitude spring forth. The second stanza reminds us of God's enduring kindness. We can take comfort in knowing how much God loves us and this can be the driving force of our lives. There ought to be a vibrancy to our prayer and praise. I can't think of a more fitting way to glorify God and express our love than the vibrancy of our own lives.

Connecting vibrancy to the acronym HARVEST comes naturally if you picture in your mind's eye the rich colors of the fall harvest of wheat and corn. The rhythm of the seasons is filled with change and transformation; what doesn't change is God's enduring and everlasting love. What can change and evolve is our desire to grow ever closer to the Lord.

We take for granted the change of seasons; yet there is a caution to taking for granted God's love. If we love someone, we reciprocate and show this love through the words, thoughts and actions of our lives. While God's love is everlasting, it does call us to respond by living and loving with generous and grateful hearts.

O God,


we pray for fidelity to prayer where we give praise and glory to you.
