## Reflection


Once while visiting New Mexico, I dropped into the Georgia O'Keeffe Museum. It had recently opened and I was excited to explore the exhibit. It's a spacious venue with limits on attendees so it was relatively quiet, people wandering around respectfully enjoying the moment and expansive creativity. For me, the venture was pensive and holy.

Where and how do we experience the Sacred in beauty? Perhaps in nature, a glorious garden, in a museum or listening to a symphony. What is your aesthetic sweet spot? Possibly you have more than one, that place of heightened awareness or serenity when encountering the sublime. As Thomas Merton shared, "Art enables us to find ourselves and lose ourselves at the same

time" (*No Man is an Island*). In taking in the beautiful, our senses ignite a liminal place where the interior and exterior converge through the mystery of contemplative presence.

It is not coincidental that places of worship are adorned to be aesthetically evocative and gratifying.
