### **Today's Gospel**

## Reflection

An Epiphany tradition in some homes includes a party in honor of the visit of

the magi or "three kings" to the Holy Family. A special cake is prepared in which a bean or a coin or, sometimes even a figure representing the baby Christ Child, is hidden. Whoever finds the concealed surprise in their piece of cake is crowned queen or king of the party.


One responsibility of the "monarch" is to lead the blessing of the home for the new year. The numbers of the new year are written over the front door along with the initials of the legendary names of the magi: Casper, Melchior, and Balthasar. (The initials also stand for the Latin phrase, "Christus mansionem benedicat," asking Christ to bless the house.) The home is dedicated to hospitality which may be seen as both given and received in the Epiphany story. Foreigners were welcomed into the home of Joseph and Mary, and they graciously acknowledged that welcome offering their precious gifts.

- In what ways might God be considered hospitable?




### **For Prayer**
