Reflection

Caterina di Jacopo di Benincasa, known as Catherine of Siena, was an Italian mystic and pious laywoman who engaged in papal and Italian politics through extensive letter-writing and advocacy. Canonized in 1461, she is revered as a saint and as a Doctor of the Church due to her extensive theological authorship. She was born March 25, 1347 in Siena, Italy and died April 29, 1380 in Rome, Italy at the age of 33.

The feast day of St. Catherine of Sinna falls within the Easter Season this

year. In my mind she is a wonderful witness to God's abiding presence dwelling in her, and she in God. It seems that the Holy Spirit endowed her with great faith, insight, and courage to address the ills of church and even society in her day. So much did she love God that the Spirit formed her in the Word of God. That Word stirred up such love and presence that she lived out loud the movements of the Spirit, addressing the ills of the world in which she lived.

She lived fervently, her love for Jesus and the Father whom she knew deep within her soul. God was home within her and flowed out to the woes and worries of her world.

She is a gracious example of *keeping God's word*, knowing the love of God, and discerning God's indwelling presence, not for herself, but for the sake of the world.

I hope and pray that you and I are people who strive to live the Word, love God, and love God's people. Jesus' bold promise is made tangible for our discernment, too. God dwells in us! Do we see it, feel it, recognize God's abiding presence within our souls and influencing our lives? You and I may not be overtly calling to task warring church officials who seem to have lost their way. However, we are no less challenged to live our relationship with God out loud by the manner of our living, relating, and working among God's people. Let us stir up love, mercy, compassion, and witness to God's abiding presence.
