Some of the inhabitants of Jerusalem said, "Is he not the one they are trying to kill? And look, he is speaking openly, and they say nothing to him. Jesus, so much will unfold in the coming weeks. You will experience betrayal by those you call your disciples.


You will be condemned by those who view themselves as religious leaders. Peter will deny you and excruciating pain will befall you.

- How might you companion someone who is struggling to pick up their own cross and continue on the journey?


For Prayer
