# An Excerpt from Today's First Reading

#### Beloved:

Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, a descendant of David: such is my Gospel, for which I am suffering, even to the point of chains, like a criminal. But the word of God is not chained. Therefore, I bear with everything for the sake of those who are chosen, so that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, together with eternal glory.

2 TIMOTHY 2:8-10

The source and center of such magnanimity most certainly is of the Spirit of God at home in us.

#### **Maxim Seven**

In the manifestation of zeal characteristic of your very humble vocation, imitate the fervor of the most zealous and embrace in desire the salvation and perfection of a whole world in a spirit replete with a true humility and a generous courage. This will bring you to wish to do everything, to suffer everything, and to undertake everything for the advancement of the glory of God and the salvation of the dear neighbor.

The friendship of the LORD is with those who [love] God, and God's covenant, for their instruction.


