

#### Reflection


It is Sunday! A day of sabbath rest and renewal in God's great love for us. The three readings today remind me that in human thinking, divisions seem unavoidable. When encountering the unfamiliar or unknown, people tend to see the other as stranger, foreigner, Gentile, Jew, Christian, Muslim, etc. We are wary of the unknown other. Throughout Scripture, this wariness is evident.

In contrast, God sees us all as Beloved and desires to awaken us to Divine presence within our very being. Our God of Love created us, holds us, and

seeks to be known. We are made for love - God's love. Each person born bears a unique reflection of God within their being. We are One in God.

God's abiding in the center of our souls is revealed in our longing for something more, our search for love and belonging, our need for security. Awakening to the reality of God's personal call to union and our countless God-given gifts, we have what we need. It is not about our worthiness; rather it is about God's great love, which sees each of us as beloved.

No matter one's life story, experiences of life, or wanderings off the path of goodness, God always abides, no matter what. God's desire to be one with each of us never lessens.
