# Reflection

In the six weeks of Lent, today is Wednesday of the fifth week. There are only

11 days left of Lent. Where has the time gone? This is a good time for hindsight reflection on the journey, to glean the graces offered, and to proceed with greater intent into Holy Week.

I have a photo of a dirt road wandering through the countryside. It is a reminder for me that I am on the road to holiness. The journey of renewal is unique to each one who embarks on the road to holiness. May I engage these last days of this year's Lenten journey


with renewed intention, so that I awake on Easter Morning more aware of You and your great love poured out in Jesus' life, death, and resurrection.
